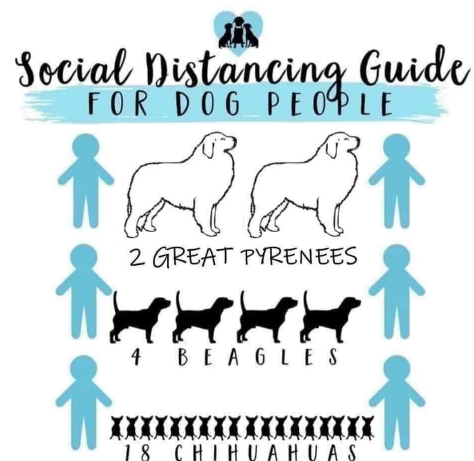
Due to the stay-at-home order, the following Club activities have been **canceled or postponed**:
